Eva C. Brooks	\$1,000 (Majoring in Music)
Willie E. Coleman	\$1,000 (Majoring in General Studies)
Corinne S. Jones	\$1,000 (Given to senior with highest rank within graduating class)
Martha M. Naylor	\$1,000 (Majoring in General Studies)
Robert E. Penn	2 @ \$700 a piece (Given to seniors who show great high school, community, and church involvement)
David H. Robertson	\$1,000 (Majoring in Business Administration)

Penn, Coleman, Robertson, Jones, Alsobrooks and Naylor are renewable for each year of undergraduate degree program completed, up to five years. This includes both two-year undergraduate Associate's degree programs or four and five year undergraduate Bachelor's degree programs.

Requirements for renewable scholarships:

- Full-time student
- Maintain a 2.5 or higher cumulative GPA
- Make satisfactory academic progress
- And renew scholarship annually
